

League Overview

Pelham Fish & Game Club is pleased to announce the third year of our Mixed Trap League for the 2012 season.

This is a fun, relaxed trap league and is open to everyone (guests & members alike).

This is a team league (minimum team size is 5 shooters, maximum is 10).

Each team shoots 250 targets per match at 16 yards. All team members present will shoot.

Each participant receives a handicap (*number of targets added to the shooter's score, based on shooter's average*) which is updated weekly. This ensures that competition is close and **shooters of all abilities can participate.**

Teams & individuals welcome.

If you don't have a team, we'll find you a team to shoot on!

From Route 38 in Pelham, NH, turn on to Hobbs Rd. Follow Hobbs Rd. for 0.3 miles. Turn right onto Simpson Mill Rd. Follow Simpson Mill Rd. for 1.0 mile. The main entrance is on the right.

Whether you are an experienced shooter that is looking to shoot an additional night/league or a new shooter that is curious about shooting trap but have been reluctant to get involved – this is a great opportunity!

If you have never shot trap before, we will offer an "Introduction to Trap" clinic during the month of March. There is no charge for this clinic, and it is not a firearms safety course.

All participants required to provide their own:

- Shotguns
- Ammunition (#7½, #8, #9)
- Hearing Protection
- Eye Protection

It is expected that all attendees are familiar with basic firearms safety.

And remember – you do **NOT** have to be a member of Pelham Fish & Game Club to participate.
